

Expanding connectivity between the EU, Türkiye and the Eastern Partnership towards Central Asia

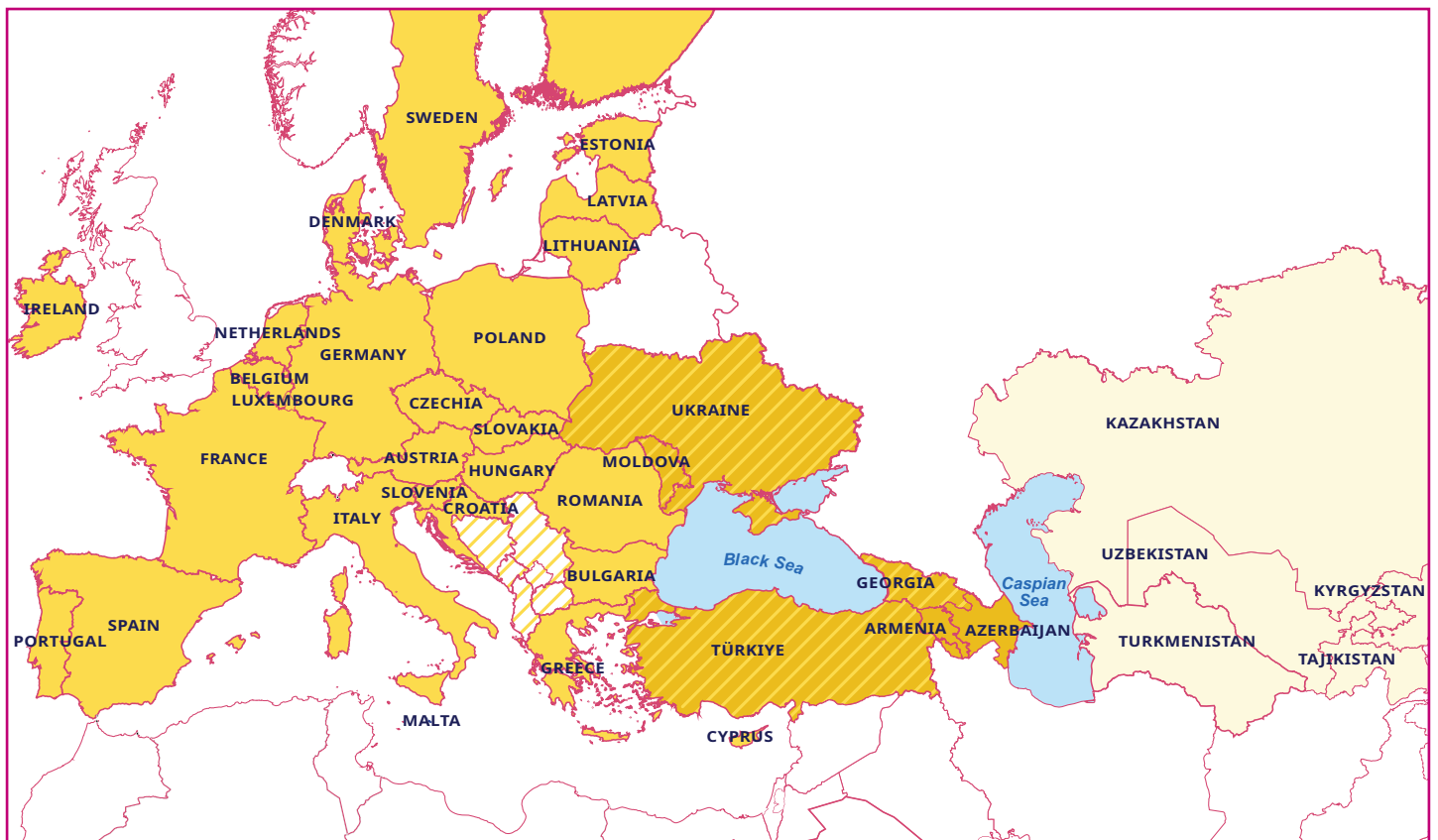
